


Fig. 1A for Question 1


Fig. 1B for Question 1






Fig 3B for Question 3 EITHER Relationship between sediment load and slope

Fig. 3A for Question 3 EITHER Relationship between channel slope and bankfull discharge





Fig. 4 for Question 3 OR Distribution of cities in 2015


Fig. 5 for Question 4 EITHER Heavily silted river in Sabah, East Malaysia





Workers clearing the silt after heavy mudflow into a water intake point in Sabah's Sungai Liwagu forced it to shut down. Heavy mudflows from Mount Kinabalu continue to torment villagers, two months after an earthquake that killed 18 people on 5th June 2015. The mudflows, responsible for flash floods and mudslides, are also choking rivers in the Malaysian state.
