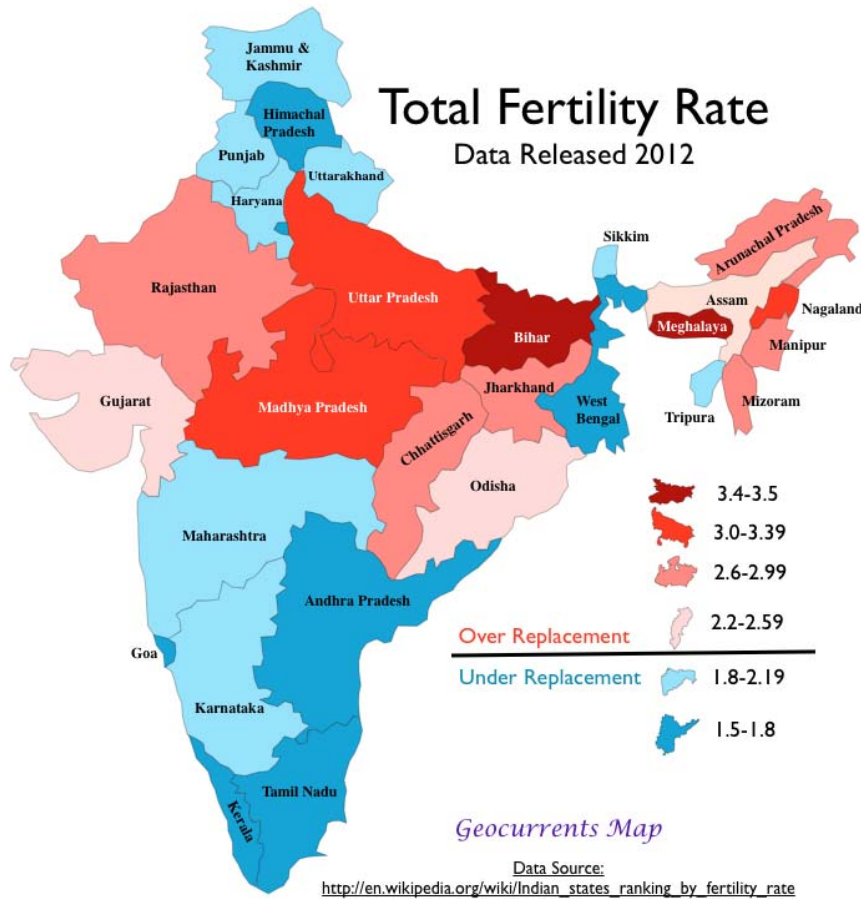

**The Abercrombie Plan for Greater London, 1944**

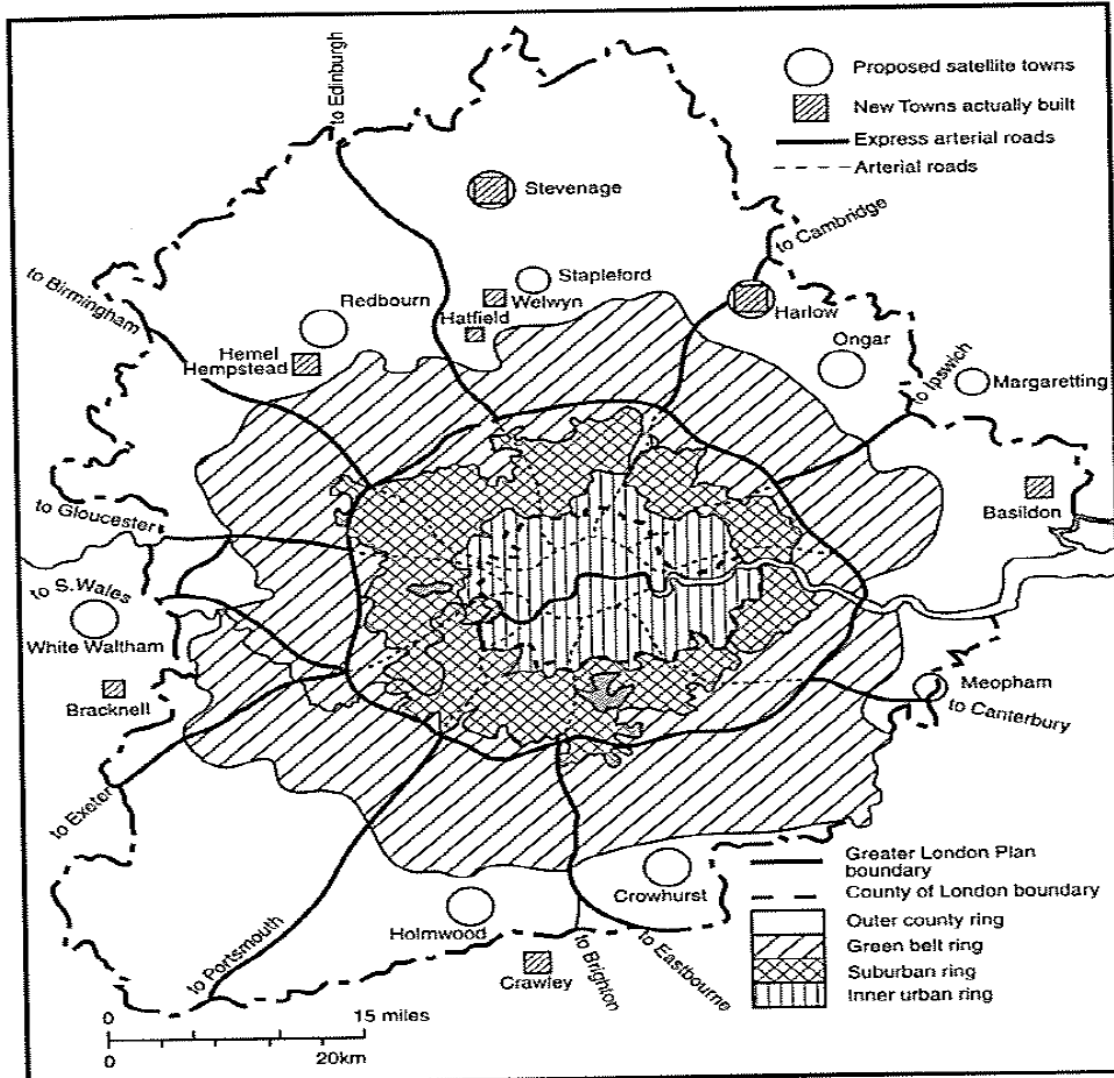
