


Figure 1A Question 1 Some Geomorphic Features Associated with Landslides



\*Note: Geomorphic refers to the branch of geology that studies the characteristics of rocks and landforms.



Figure 1B for Question 1 Factors affecting the Risk of Mass Movements





Figure 2A for Question 2 Proportional map of the world by Gross National Product, 1998









Figure 5A for Question 4 EITHER A Stretch of a Channel in an Alpine Mountainous Area





