 - c) Explain how you would draw up a hazard map of an earthquake-prone region, identifying the areas of high and low risks. [2]

- **2** Fig. 2 depicts a process in the developed countries.
 - a) Briefly describe what Fig. 2 is trying to depict. [2]
 - b) Explain how the use of new technology can account for the process shown in Fig. 2.[4]
 - c) Compare the processes of 'deindustrialization' and 'reindustrialization'. [2]
 - d) With reference to examples, describe how reindustrialization can take place. [4]

- 3 Figs 3A and 3B are two drainage basins of approximately the same area.
 - a) From Figs 3A and 3B, state which drainage basin
 - (i) has a greater discharge at the gauging station
 - (ii) will record a flood first at the gauging station if similar storms hit both basins at the same time.
 - (iii) has a higher stream order,
 - (iv) has a higher bifurcation ratio (show your working). [5]
 - b) Explain the reasons for your answer to (a)(iii) [2]
 - c) What factors might cause a drainage basin such as B to have a higher drainage density than one such as A? [5]
