- 1 Resource 1 shows the course of the River Nile from its source to the Mediterranean Sea. Resource 2 shows population growth for the countries within the River Nile drainage basin. Resource 3 shows an extract from an academic article on transboundary water conflicts in the River Nile drainage basin. Resource 4 shows Egypt's performance in the various SDGs in 2023.
 - (a) With reference to Resource 1, describe the distribution of dams along the River Nile. [4]
 - **(b)** Suggest **two** ways how the construction of dams can compromise the ability of rivers to provide ecosystem services. [4]
 - (c) With reference to Resources 1 and 2, suggest **two** reasons why conflicts over access to water will occur between countries in the River Nile drainage basin. [5]
 - (d) With reference to Resource 3, explain the limitations of water treaties in managing conflicts in transboundary river basins. [6]
 - (e) With reference to Resource 4, describe Egypt's progress towards meeting the SDGs. [6]
 - (f) Explain why it is difficult to accurately measure progress towards sustainable development, such as that of Egypt shown in Resource 4. [5]
