Generative AI tools such as OpenAI's ChatGPT have been herald as pivotal for the world of work, with the potential to increase employees' productivity by automation tedious tasks and sparking creative solutions to challenging problems. However, as the technology is being integrated to human-resources platforms and other workplace tools, it was creating a formidable challenge of corporate America.
